Application for consent under the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 (e-planning Online Reference Number: 100719963) to undertake the decommissioning of the existing wind farm and erection of up to 7 turbines and ancillary development on land around Carn Gaibhre to the east of Beinn Ghlas summit on the Barguillean Estate, in the administrative area of Argyll and Bute Council

Dear Mr Ramsay,

Please find enclosed an application for consent under the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997. The application is made by Beaufort Wind Limited (the Applicant). The Applicant is proposing to decommission the existing wind farm and erect up to 7 turbines (the Proposed Development) and ancillary development on land around Carn Gaibhre to the east of Beinn Ghlas summit on the Barguillean Estate.

The Proposed Development is located approximately 12 km east of Oban and 4 km south-west of Taynuilt, as shown in **Figure 1.1** of the submitted EIA Report, entirely within the Argyll and Bute Council local authority area.

The Proposed Development would involve decommissioning the existing Beinn Ghlas Wind Farm, which consists of 14 wind turbines (approximately 54.1 m to blade tip), each with a capacity of 600 kilowatts (kW) and repowering the Site with up to 7 turbines of up to 149.9 m to tip and associated infrastructure, with a generating capacity of approximately 30 - 40 MW. Further details in relation to the Proposed Development are available in **Chapter 2: Proposed Development and Design Evolution** of the EIA Report.

Joanna Thornton Project Development and Management Services Ltd is appointed as the agent and RSK Environment Limited (RSK) is appointed as lead EIA consultant for this application and hereby submits this





application to Argyll and Bute Council on behalf of the Applicant. The fee for the application has been paid in full on 16th July 2025.

Environmental Impact Assessment
